

SRGC Marksmanship Courses

MP 100

The 100 level course is a basic firearms orientation class for new shooters. It is intended to be flexible and will give a general overview of weapon function and safety as well as the basics of shooting to include grip, stance, sight package, trigger control, etc. There is no drawing from the holster or weapon transitions in this class. It is not a prerequisite for the MP 101 course but is highly recommended to shooters that have never had any instruction.

MP 101

The 101 course certifies shooters as being able to safely draw from the holster and conduct weapon transitions. Time will not be dedicated specifically to improving shot placement or groups. Instead, the course will focus on safe and effective weapons handling. A card is given to each shooter after successfully completing the course that allows them to draw and transition at normal pistol/rifle ranges.

MP 201

MP 201 will place a combined emphasis on efficient weapons handling and accuracy while under a shot timer. It will also incorporate the VTAC barricade to practice shooting from unconventional positions. Attendees are required to have successfully completed MP 101.

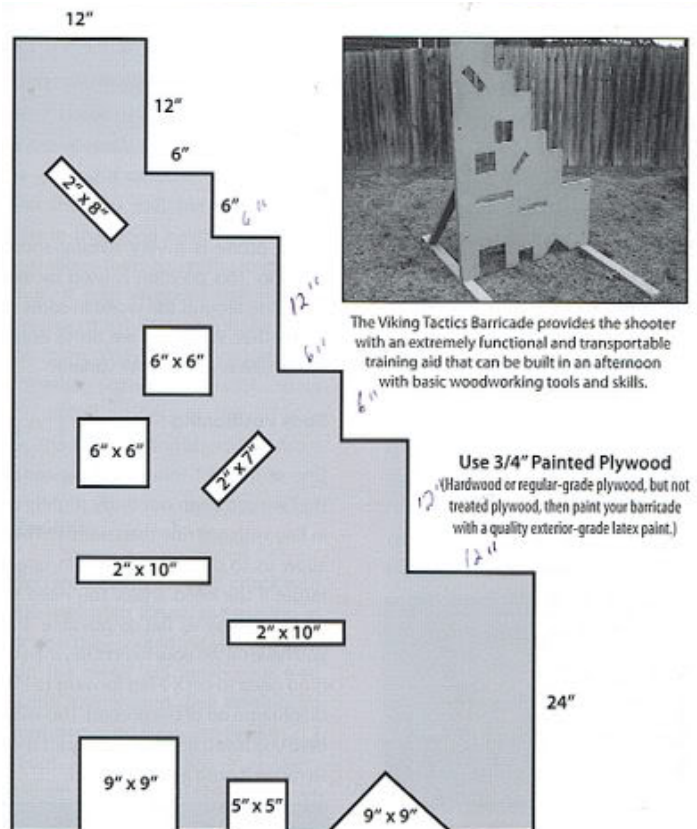

- Two or more magazines per weapon
- Method of carrying spare magazines
- Ear protection (electronic recommended)
- Eye protection
